

Sidney Velo Motor-assisted Cycle Policy (E-cycles) adopted 25 September 2021

E-cycles are permitted on club rides subject to the following caveats:

- They comply with the B.C. Motor Vehicle Act Motor Assisted Cycle Regulation 151/2002, including:
 - electric motor not exceeding 500 watts
 - 32 km/h maximum assist speed
 - no assist if not applying significant pedaling force
- E-cycles should not set the pace of the ride, unless expressly asked to do so by the peloton, such as into a headwind.
- E-cycles should normally be at the back of the peloton, unless the E-cycle rider is the ride leader, and should not use the motor to pass unmotorized riders on hills.
- E-cycles must abide by the Sidney Velo Peloton Etiquette guidelines (<http://sidneyvelo.ca/peloton-etiquette/>).
